Arrow-wood ***	6-15' Shrub, flowers in June, Sept black fruit, attracts birds	Adaptable to all soils and climates	H, E, N
Balsam Fir	Small to medium size tree, popular Christmas tree	Tolerant of most soils	C, T, H, W, E, N
Bittersweet American ***	20' Climbing vine. Yellow Orange Fruit	Poor soils, full sun	H, N
Blackberry	8-10' Shrub, Black Fruit	Tolerant of soil types, hardy	F, H, W, N
Black Cherry	50 ft. Tree- Fruit is good for making wine and jelly	Tolerates variety of conditions	H, T, N, F, E
Black Walnut	50' High and wide tree.	Prefers moist soil	H, F, T, N
Blueberry	Vigorous erect bush, Medium sweet berries	Hardy and drought resistant	F, H, N
Blue Iris***	Light blue flower, blooms throughout June		C,E,F,H,N,S,T,W
Butterfly Bush	5-12 ft. Shrub- Multi stemmed, fragrant	Tolerates variety of conditions	H
Crabapple Sargent ***	6-8 High tree. Edible fruit	Prefers well drained soils	H, F, S
Dogwood Redoiser	7-9 Slender shrub. Red stem with white drupe fruit	Does well in wet, swampy conditions	H, E, N
Douglas Fir	50-60 ft. Tree- Blue-green, needles have fruity fragrance	Well drained soils, medium sun	C, T, H, W, E
Elderberry	5-12 ft. Shrub- June white flowers, August purple berries	Tolerates variety of conditions	H, S, E, N
Fern Cinnamon ***	2'5' height. First foliage appears as cinnamon sticks, green waxy leaves, dormant in Sept	Prefers acid soils	E, H, N
Fraser Fir	40-60 ft. Tree- Narrow, pyramidal tree, dark green needles	Well drained soils	C, T, H, W, E
Fir Concolor	Tall tree, Flattened needles, silvery blue-green	Tolerates variety of conditions	C, T, W, E
Forsythia ***	8-10' Upright wide shrub. Yellow flowers in April	Prefers loose soil, requires full sun	H
Lilac	8-12 ft. Shrub- Fragrant flowers in mid-may	Well drained to moist soils	E, S
Ninebark ***	5-9' Spreading shrub. May-June white flowers. Sept Fruit	Tolerates full sun and dry conditions	E, N
Poplar Hybrid	100' upright rapid growing tree. Great windbreak	Well drained to moist soils	T, S, E
Raspberry	Upright bush, blooms spring, berries mid summer	Well drained soils, full sun	F, H, N, W
Red Oak	70 ft Symmetrical Tree, great timber tree	Prefers sandy soil	H, T, E, N, W
Red Maple	60 ft. Tree with equal spread, fall colors. Strong wood	Tolerant, prefers slightly acid	H, T, E, N, W
Rose of Sharon ***	8-12 Erect shrub. Flowers July through Sept	Tolerates moist soils, full sun	H
Spruce Colorado Blue	Up to 100 ft. Tree. Brilliant blue-green color	Tolerates variety of conditions	C, T, H, S, E
Sassafras	30-60' Aromatic tree shrub, blackberry fruit attracts birds	Moist, particularly sandy soils, sun	F, H
Serviceberry***	Small tree, white flowers in Apr, fruit ripening in June	Moist, well drained acid soils	C,E,F,H,N,S,T,W
Spicebush	Shrub produces flowers Mar-Apr, tea can be made from leaves	Well drained moist soils	C,E,F,H,N,S,T,W
Spruce Norway	Medium to large tree. Stiff, needles sharp tip	Tolerates variety of conditions	C, T, H, S, E
Spruce White	Medium size tree, needles are pointed but not sharp	Tolerates variety of conditions	C, T, H, S, E, N
Sugar Maple	50 ft. Tree, deciduous, sap for syrup, fall foliage	Prefers well drained soil	H, T, S, E, N
Sunset Daylily***	36" Perennial, Flower	Highly adaptable thrives	E
Tulip Tree	70-90 ft. Fast growing tree. Flower May-June	Full sun, well drained loam	T
Willow Stream-Co	8-10 Round dense shrub. Stabilizes stream banks	Wet areas	H, W, E
Witch Hazel***	10-20 ft. Tree, flowers yellow, fruit	Tolerates variety of conditions	H, E, N
White Cedar	Up to 50 ft. Tree, flowers in March, cones ripen autumn	Tolerates variety of conditions	H, S, E, N, T, W
White Oak	60 ft. Tree, slow growing, great feed for wildlife	Tolerates variety of conditions	T, H, W, E, N
White Pine	100-150 ft. Tree, growth rapid at first, soft needles	Moist well drained soil, full sun	C,T,H,W,S,E,N
